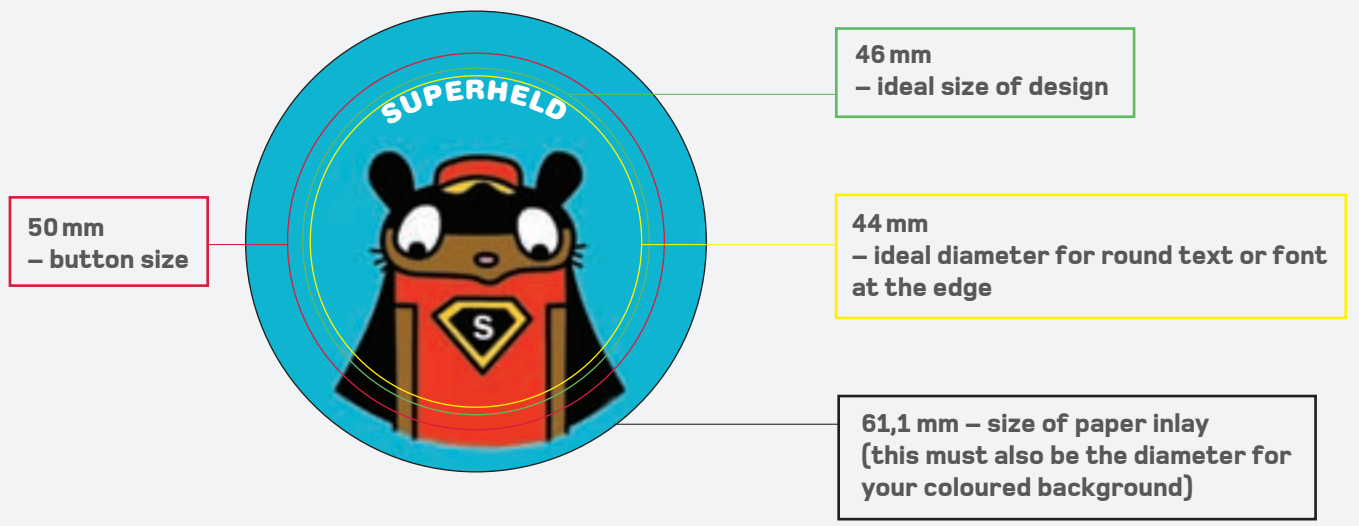
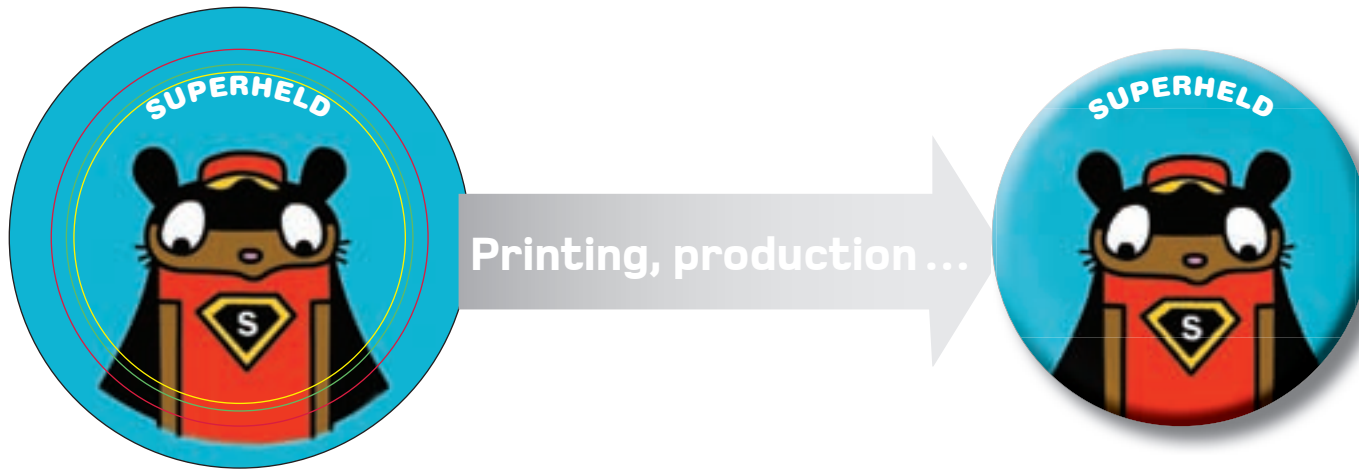
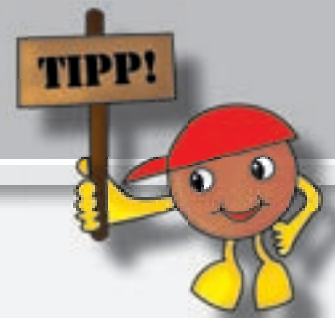


50 mm Button – How to succeed ...



Attention:

Resolution: minimum 300 dpi
Colour Mode: CMYK (not RGB!)

File Formats:

PDF = the file format .pdf can be generated with all current layout programmes and is the ideal file format for data exchange.

EPS = can be generated with many current layout programmes. The .eps-format can contain/describe pixel data as well as vector data.

TIFF = can be generated with many different image editing applications. The .tiff-file can only save pixel-based data.

JPEG = can be generated with image editing applications. The .jpg-format can only save pixel-based data and is lossy.

Further file formats generated with graphic software:

AI = Adobe Illustrator file

IND = InDesign file

CDR = Corel Draw file (up to version 10)



Our hints concerning your 50 mm button:



Primarily the 50 mm button was mainly located in the cup sector. Meanwhile it is becoming more and more favoured as a matured allrounder. By now also available with metal backside, the 50 mm button is no more ranking behind the classic 59 mm button in any way.

Print your design ...

...yourself in a scale of 1:1 before you send it to us. This way you can see if all elements are well placed and if they are clearly visible / readable.



Partially shown designs (bleed)...

...cut across the diameter for the ideal size of design. Depending on your design this effect can be pretty appealing. In principle there are not limits for your own creativity...

Technically caused there are **shifting tolerances** occurring in the different steps of the production. These are max. 1 mm in total. Because of that round text or coloured edges should not be located too close to the border of the button.



You want to order **printed buttons with different designs**? Then you can split the total order quantity- and save money by that. Preconditions: Same button size & backside variation, same colour mode (CMYK or the same HKS or Pantone spot colours) & minimum order quantity (100 pieces per design for a CMYK printing, 500 pieces per design for a Pantone or HKS printing).

Because of the fitting accuracy always in demand:

The 50 mm button in the cup sector (for this purpose without safety pin and pasted up).
